Scientology says that OTs are "Cause over matter, energy, space and time." Hubbard claimed in the very early days of Scientology that his "mental technology" transformed human beings into gods. These "gods" that all the exact application of the tech produced over fifty years are what are now called OTs. ² between-lives area: According to Hubbard, after body death the person, called in Scientology the "thetan," goes to an implant station, usually on Mars. In this between-lives area, the individual is psychologically brutalized by suppressively evil implanters, whom Hubbard equated with psychiatrists. (Ref.: HCOB 25 Nov 1971 Resistive Cases Former Therapy) If the newly departed was not "proofed up" before death against this atrocity with Scientology processing, the implanters wipe his memory banks and send him back to Earth to "pick up" a new body.

BETWEEN-LIVES: At death the theta being leaves the body and goes to the between-lives area. Here he "reports in", is given a strong forgetter implant and then is shot down to a body just before it is born. At least that is the way the old invader in the Earth area was operating.
